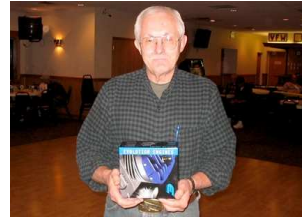

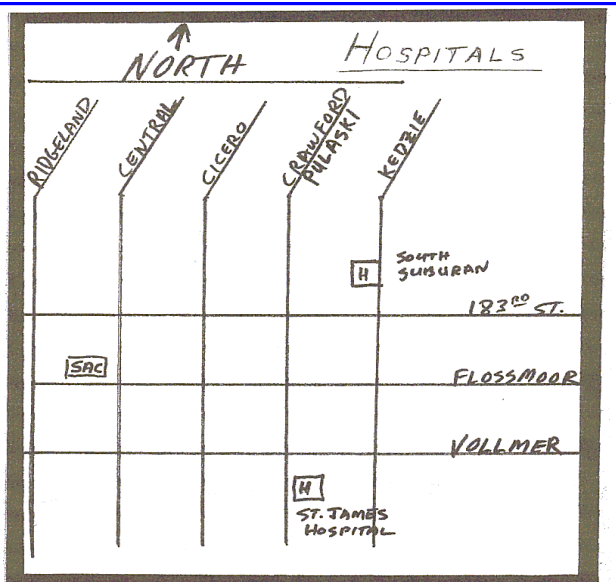

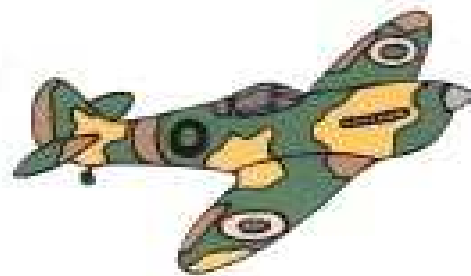

First Flight of 2009

For brave souls only. Official sunrise is 7:18 am on January 1, 2009, but takeoff can be any time after midnight as long as you have a witness that will vouch for you. Gate will be open at 6:00 am

RULES

1. Must be **FIXED WING** aircraft.
2. No lights ON aircraft.
3. You must takeoff from **SAC's runway**, grass or black top.
4. You must takeoff from the **ground** (wheels, skis, skids, etc) no hand launches.
You must fly for **two minutes**. Your assistant will vouch for you.
6. You can land (or crash) anywhere you want as long as you complied with the two minutes flight time

For the winners efforts you will get a First Flight Patch.

SAC ANNUAL TURKEY SHOOT

Don't forget the Annual Turkey Shoot. It'll be on November 2nd, and start sharply at 9am. I'm not sure what we'll do yet but it won't be very difficult. Everyone should be able to participate. Last year we had 15 participants and everyone had fun. The events I'm thinking about are 2 flights. First flight. Take off and do 3 aileron rolls and 3 loops, then land. Trying to do it in the shortest amount of time. Next I think we'll do a climb and glide. Climb for 30 seconds. Kill your engine and land.

This time you'll try and stay up as long as you can. All easy events that everyone can do. See you out there.

IMPORTANT NEWS FROM THE PRESIDENT REGARDING OUR FLYING FIELD

I got a call from a reporter questioning me about us losing our field. He said someone called, upset that we were being moved and we would be stranded. I explained this is entirely wrong. I just met with the CCFPD (Cook County Forest Preserve District) Superintendent last Tuesday (10/21) and was again assured all is going well. They are hiring a consulting firm to look at our proposed new site and requirements and will make sure all our needs are met. I have connected the CCFPD with our AMA area representative who told me the plans look good. Money is being budgeted and all is going well. We don't need or want any negative publicity. My wife and I are going next week (10/28) to speak to the County Board and Mr. Stroger. I will speak of our field and my wife Susan will discuss equipment accessibility issues that she was asked to participate in with the Forest Preserve. I asked the reporter not to run with any negative story as the CCFPD is working with us to get us moved into an adequate site. Please if anyone has any questions ask me any we will get them resolved.
